If you need a student visa:

Students who wish to study in a full-time program in the U.S. must have an F-1 student visa. You cannot study with a tourist (B1/B2) visa or on the visa waiver program. If you have another type of visa and do not wish to change, please contact us to find out if this is possible. If you will be a full-time student in a United States school beginning in the fall, you can generally enter the U.S. 30 days before the reporting date on your I-20. If you will enter Columbia University in the fall, contact the admissions office for your academic program to receive special instructions. If you will enter another school in the United States immediately after this program, contact their International Student Office to find out if you will need a separate I-20 for this summer program. To receive an I-20 form from the American Language Program, you must send us your completed application form, checks, a copy of your passport, a copy of your TOEFL score, copies of your acceptance letter to an LLm Program or law school transcripts (if applying to English for Professional Purposes: Law) and copies of the required financial documentation:

- A bank statement showing the amount in your bank account or your sponsor's bank account. Please note that the official estimate for a one month course at the ALP is \$2,500 for tuition and \$2,200 for living expenses. Living expenses, however, may vary greatly. A minimum budget of approximately \$4,700 should be sufficient for most students.
- If you will be submitting a sponsor's bank statement, a sponsor's affidavit of support is also required. It must state that he or she promises to support you financially in your studies at the American Language Program.

All financial documents should be dated within the last three months. After we receive your completed application form, checks, TOEFL score and financial documents, we will send you the I-20 AB form and Letter of Acceptance. Please keep the originals of all of the financial documents. You will bring them to the U.S. Embassy or Consulate along with the I-20 AB form and your Letter of Acceptance. The consulate or embassy will give you your student visa.
